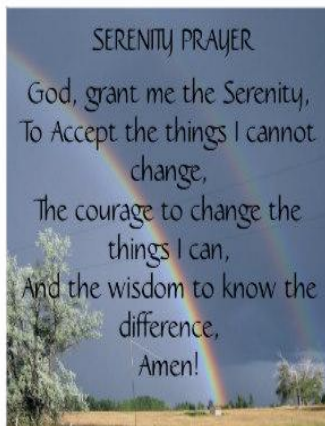
Delegates Will Be Elected at our February Meeting for the LFRW Biennial Convention

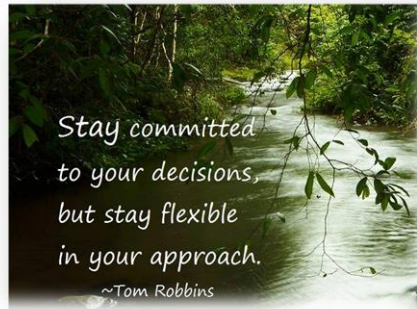
