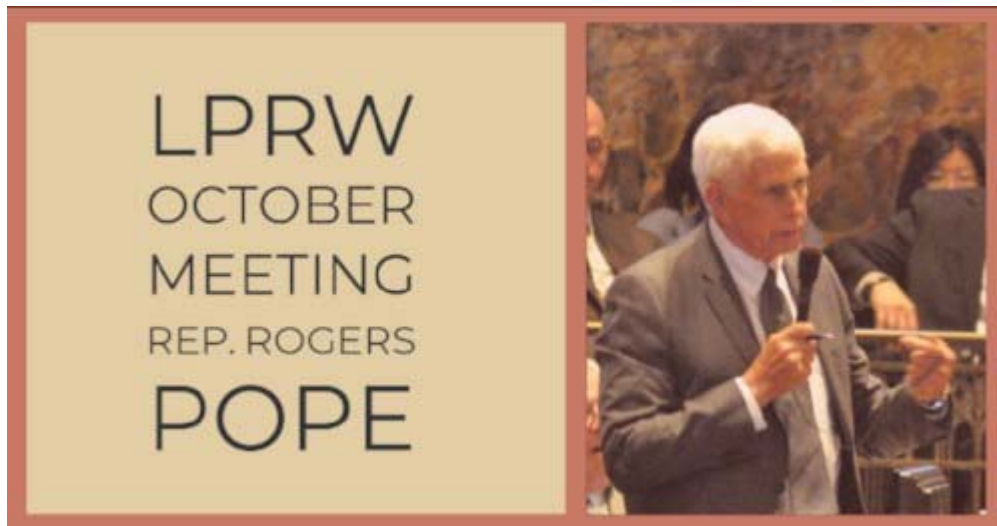

How can you support the nomination of Judge Kavanaugh?

- **Call your Senators** (even though they are supporting Judge Kavanaugh, they need to hear from you – calls from the left are flooding in).
- **Call Republican Senators** Jeff Flake (AZ), Lisa Murkowski (AK), and Susan Collins (ME). They need to hear from Republican women.
- **Call Democrat Senators** in tight reelection races, such as Bill Nelson (FL), Joe Donnelly (IN), Heidi Heitkamp (ND), John Tester (MT), and Joe Manchin (WV)

Important information for the Nov. 6, 2018 Open Primary/Congressional Election

- The deadline to **register** to vote in person or by mail is Oct. 9 (deadline advanced one day because of Columbus Day Holiday).
- The deadline to **register** to vote through the GeauxVote Online Registration System is Oct. 16.
- **Early voting** is Oct. 23-30 (except Sunday, Oct. 28) from 8:30 a.m.-6 p.m.
- The deadline to request an **absentee** by mail ballot is Nov. 2 by 4:30 p.m. Voters can request an absentee by mail ballot online through the Louisiana Secretary of State [Voter Portal](#) or in writing through your Registrar of Voters Office (other than military and overseas voters).
- The deadline for a registrar of voters to receive a voted mail ballot is Nov. 5 by 4:30 p.m. (other than military and overseas voters).

***Statistically 1 active volunteer equals 7 votes.
