The St. Tammany School Board meetings are all open to the public. The meetings are also live-streamed at https://www.youtube.com/stppschools. Recordings of the meetings are made available for viewing immediately after the live stream ends, at https://go.boarddocs.com/la/stpsb/Board.nsf/Public. At the latter site you can also view and/or print the meeting agenda. All meetings are held at the St. Tammany Parish School Board C. J. Schoen Administrative Complex (321 N. Third St., Covington, LA) unless otherwise noted.

The New Directions 2040 Draft Comprehensive Plan has been adopted by the St. Tammany Parish Planning Commission. It is available to review and a copy of the draft plan can be downloaded at <u>www.newdirections2040.com</u>.

The St Tammany Parish Council approved a six-month moratorium on new houses near Slidell in the area that includes the 275-acre Honeybee development. During the moratorium, no rezoning or resubdivision requests may be submitted, and no residential building permits may be issued. . Moratorium calls for a study to determine impact on drainage, wetlands, roads and drainage, long term growth and responsible development of the area.

Election Dates for 2023:

April 29, 2023 - Municipal General Election

- Early voting is April 15-22 (excluding Sunday, April 16) from 8:30 a.m.-6 p.m.
- The deadline to request an absentee ballot is April 25 by 4:30 p.m (other than military and overseas voters). You can request an absentee ballot online through our Voter Portal or in writing through your Registrar of Voters Office.
- The deadline for a registrar of voters to receive a voted absentee ballot is April 28 by 4:30 p.m. (other than military and overseas voters).
- On election day, the polls are open from 7 a.m.-8 p.m.

One item is one the ballot for the Lacombe area. The St Tammany Coroner's Office is asking voters to approve a renewal of 3.10 mills tax, which expires 2024, to fund operations at the Coroner's Office. The tax, originally approved 20 years ago as a 4-mills property tax to build the the new facility and DNA Lab in Lacombe and pay for the agency's operations, would take effect in 2025 and expire in 2044. Coroner Charles Preston the renewal is needed for to provide the same level of services. Parish President Mike Cooper is against the renewal saying it is more than the it needs since bonds for the facility will be paid off next year, and Concerned Citizens of St Tammany are against the renewal stating the intent was for the tax to sunset after the loan for the new facility was paid off.
