MESSAGE FROM STATE REPRESENTATIVE JULIE STOKES

Dear Friends,

Now, more than ever before, I'm noticing the milestones of renewal throughout the year. Back in December, I shared about the feelings of refreshment surrounding the Christmas season in celebration of the birth of Christ. Then in January, the New Year brings its own "newness." As we enjoy springtime and prepare to celebrate Easter, I'm once again filled with gratitude for another opportunity to reflect on God's grace.

This past week in the legislature was one of much reflection as well, as I had several bills heard (and pass) committee that would positively impact breast cancer patients and survivors. Working with friends from the Karen T. Stall Research and Breast Institute, Ochsner Health System, LSU Health System, University Medical Center and more, these measures could lead to more opportunities for earlier detection and continued screenings. A quick summary of each bill is below:

HB 460 - A bill that requires health insurances to cover 3D mammograms, as they allow cancer to be detected much sooner than traditional mammography.

HB 584 - A bill that creates a license for genetic counselors. Genetic counselors evaluate a patient's family medical history to determine the genetic risk for medical conditions and diseases. Their work can be instrumental in the early diagnosis of diseases - including breast cancer.

HB 690 - A bill that requires health insurances to cover an annual preventative cancer screening for anyone who was previously diagnosed with breast cancer, completed treatment for the breast cancer, underwent a bilateral mastectomy, and was subsequently determined to be clear of cancer.
