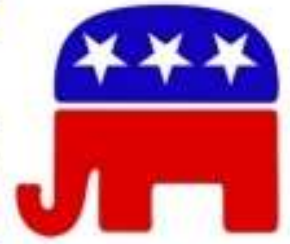

Lincoln-Reagan Day Banquet A Huge Success

I am very proud to be the President of Mandeville Republican Women! We had the largest representation at the Seventeenth Annual Lincoln-Reagan Day Banquet of any of the Republican organizations hosting the event.

This event was originally a Northshore Republican Men's Club production. became involved many years ago when they were having difficulty. I had been involved with the NRMC decorating their events and helping their treasurer check in the attendees as they did not require payment in advance which we know is very problematic. Since then, the host committee has grown from two Republican organizations in one parish to nine Republican organizations in two parishes. We are the only two parishes in Louisiana to have this working relationship. I am very proud to have promoted this growth.

There were 208 reservations! We had Republican Women from Jefferson and Orleans parishes as well as St. Tammany, Washington and Tangipahoa Parishes in attendance.

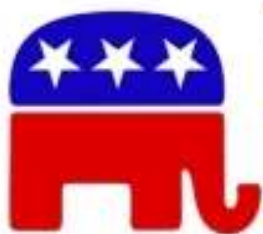

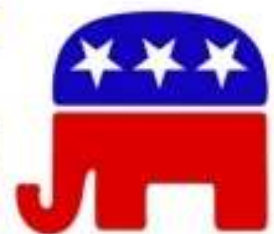

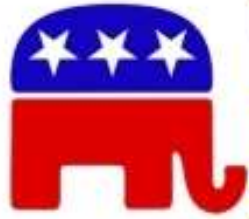
May MRW Meeting

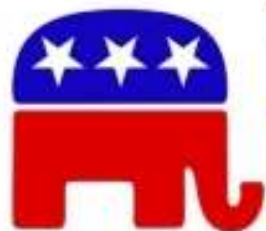

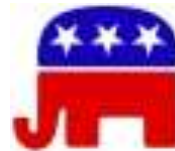
