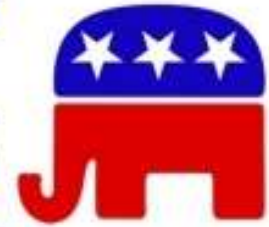

The St. Tammany Federation of Teachers which is the local, dues supporting chapter of the ultra-left wing American Federation of Teachers whose national president is radical Randi Weingarten (need I say more) is attempting to use our hardworking bus drivers to increase their control in St. Tammany Parish schools. The union has been dominating school board meetings and social media for months attempting to strong arm our elected leaders and school system administration for more pay for bus drivers who are feeling effects of inflation brought about by the president their dues helped elect.

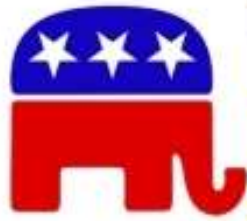

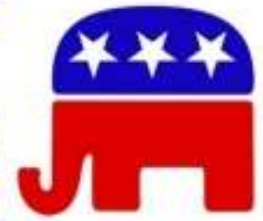

## “What Are Republicans For?”

I believe we live in the greatest country on Earth, a country which should welcome lawful immigration and stand opposed to illegal immigration. I believe all citizens should have the right to vote in safe and legal elections, and that the integrity of the process is enhanced by presenting a form of identification.
