

President's Message February 2023

If you missed it, You **really** missed it!

At MRW meeting on January 5 guest speakers Secretary of State Kyle Ardoin--who is in charge of all voting in the state and Clerk of Court Melisa Henry--who oversees the actual voting in the precincts of St. Tammany Parish, both having full knowledge of voting equipment available and voting processes and of the bill passed by our legislature stating the requirements, confirmed that there are devices available upon which we can cast our votes which will tally votes and produce an auditable paper trail which does not require the voter to hand-handle a paper ballot. I asked for and received Kyle's assurance we will not have a paper ballot anyone has to handle when we go to vote. Nothing will change until spring of 2024 as this is a long, drawn-out process.

This is what we want!

These devices produce a paper ballot that the voter never touches and a cash register type tape containing all the voting information both of which can be stored in case questions arise about the election. This fulfills the requirement for an auditable paper trail. Louisiana is rated #5 in the nation for voting integrity. This is due to the meticulous rules and extreme care given by the Secretary of State's office and the Clerks of Court offices even to the point of hand delivering voting machine counters to keep all reporting of voting tallies off the internet. Additionally, all voting machine software is installed by the Sec. of State's office and not the Vendor. All this was fully explained by Kyle and Melissa. Kyle dispelled all the misinformation that is being bantered about.

It was very impressive!

We will continue to follow the process until completed informing you along the way in case we need to take action.






