

MRW By-Laws: Article IV - Membership in this club shall be open to any woman who is a registered Republican.

Amendment: Article IV - Membership in this club shall he open to any **biological female** who is a registered Republican.

In accordance with our By-Laws, we will vote to approve this amendment at our meeting on November 2.


Understanding the guidelines for lunch reservations:


Reserve your seat by contacting Linda Esquerre, <u>renlin92@bellsouth.net</u>, 504-782-2920.

Minutes of October 5th Meeting

Linda Begue called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m.

Joyce Laporte led us in prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Michelle Pichon introduced the candidates for St. Tammany Sheriff, and Suzanne Crow presided over the forum.

The candidates introduced themselves and explained their platforms, citing facts that they felt made them the best candidate for the position. They then answered questions that were provided to them.

Reports of Officers:

Recording Secretary Joyce Laporte's minutes from September 7th were accepted and filed.

1st VP Michelle Pichon said that Public Service Commissioner Eric Skrmetta would be our November speaker.

2nd VP Lynn Pablovich said there are 78 Active members and 33 Associate members.

Treasurer Dorothy Noriea gave the Year-to-Date Financial statement

Corresponding Secretary Judy Hermann sent sympathy cards to Suzanne Crow and to Barbara Doyle for the passing of their husbands, and Linda Begue extended everyone's sympathies for the passing of Judy Hermann's mother.

Reports of Chairmen:

RPEC: Linda Begue said RPE is funding a big "Get Out the Vote" effort including text messaging to reach those Republicans who fail to get out and vote.

LFRW: Linda Begue is awaiting an official report from LFRW about the NFRW convention. New Officers were elected, and all were nominated from the floor. No slated candidates were elected, due to conflicting believes about the definition of what is a woman.

New Business

The Board is proposing a By-Law change to Article IV which currently reads, "Membership in this club shall be open to any woman who is a registered Republican." The changed By-Law is to read, "Membership in this club shall be open to any biological female who is a registered Republican." An important video by Harmeet Dillon will be sent to you to help you understand the importance of this change. Per our By-Laws, we will vote on this change at the November 2nd meeting.

Dee Betz announced that a fundraiser by Free NOLA will be held October 21st at the Fleur De Lis Center in Mandeville. Her report covered the heart-wrenching sex trafficking of children here in Louisiana and she passed out brochures showing pictures of missing children. Dee explained the work that Free LA does in a feverish effort to end sex trafficking in our state.

50/50: Was won by Jerry Rodgers, who donated the winnings to Free NOLA.

Special Door Prize: The book <u>Tucker</u>, donated by Suzanne Crow, was won by Donna Dardar.

Announcements:

November 2nd meeting reservations must be made by October 25. Beau Chene is requiring us to provide a final count by that time. No-shows will have to pay for their missed meeting.

Barbara Doyle gave out brochures for Rotary Club Christmas wreaths that are for sale.

Linda Begue adjourned the meeting at 12:35.




